


Ending Homelessness by Restoring Lives

Today, just as it has for 26 years, DuPage PADS continues to provide hope for men, women and children who are homeless. Moving beyond providing shelter and meals, DuPage PADS has evolved to provide an array of services which seeks to STOP THE CYCLE OF HOMELESSNESS in DuPage County.



(73% percent listed their last address in DuPage County.)

65% of people served have a high school diploma or higher.

Housing + Support + Employment = Solution to End Homelessness

Housing Meals, Safety & Support

- 27 interim (overnight) housing sites throughout DuPage County
- 32,063 nights of shelter for 1,079 individuals
- 106,981 meals served at overnight sites and Client Service Center
- Interim Housing was provided 365 days
- 64 apartments for individuals and families in Permanent Supportive Housing
- 286 individuals (24%) exited with an • identified placement and location

Support **Empowering Individuals**

- Support occurs within the first 72 hours of initial contact with DuPage PADS
- 7,925 meals were served at the daytime Client Service Center where individuals can access services and engage in case management/life coaching support
- 80% of those over age 17 participated in groups, education and/or individual goal planning
- More than 50 health, legal and social service agencies; More than 130 congregations and organizations
- More than 4,000 volunteers

Employment Employment Readiness



- Partnership with College of DuPage and Literacy DuPage to offer GED classes on-site
- 14 graduated and received GED certificates since January 2010
- 127 jobs were found for 178 clients seeking job assistance (71%)
- 77 (61%) maintained employment for 90 days or longer
- 18 completed computer/financial literacy training
- Active job coaching, mentor programs and job club activities

DuPage PADS – Providing Hope for 26 Years

The solution to end homelessness is more complex than providing individuals with food and shelter. DuPage PADS offers housing coupled with support services in order to help individuals work toward becoming self-sufficient. These vital support services enable the individuals we help to receive case management and life coaching, employment support such as GED courses and job coaching, as well as engagement with employers.

The current economy is changing the face of homelessness. More and more we are seeing families who have lost their housing and children showing up at our doorsteps.

DuPage PADS is the largest provider of interim (overnight) housing.

DuPage PADS is the largest provider of permanent supportive housing units

with 64 in DuPage County for individuals and families.

84% have been in their housing for one year or more.
